# INFORMATION FOR PARENTS/GUARDIANS RE: PROCEDURES FOR KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION SEPTEMBER 2018

1. To register for **English Kindergarten** do so at your catchment school.
  - North Zone: Sidney, KÉLSET, Deep Cove
  - Central Zone: Keating, Brentwood
  - South Zone: Cordova Bay, Lochside, Prospect Lake
2. To register children for **French Immersion Kindergarten** do so at:
  - Keating School (South & Central Zone)
  - Deep Cove School (North Zone)
3. To **register siblings** of students who currently attend a Saanich Elementary School but live 'Out of Catchment' or 'Out of District', register at the older child's school.
4. To register at a school **outside of your catchment area**:
  - Go to your catchment school
  - Complete the District Registration Form and
  - Complete an "*Out of catchment area application*" form
  - Leave all registration forms at the catchment school

(every effort will be made to confirm placements by the end of June when possible – September 17<sup>th</sup> at the latest)
5. To complete the District Registration Form, you will **need to bring**:
  - Child's Care Card
  - Proof of the child's birth date (e.g., Birth Certificate or Passport)
  - Proof of address (e.g., Driver's License, utility bill)
6. Placement in schools and classes is the responsibility of the School District and the school.
7. Children shall be placed according to the following SD63 priorities:

1 - re-enrolling students**	4 - non-catchment siblings
2 - catchment area siblings	5 - non-catchment children
3 - catchment area children	6 - out of district children

\*\*A child who, in the previous year, attended the school
8. If your registration information changes between February and September 2018 please inform the school.
