UPDATE ON CONSTRUCTION

FROM DISTRICT OF SAANICH WEB SITE West Saanich Road and Prospect Lake Road / Sparton Road Intersection


Start Date: February 2022 End Date: Fall/Winter 2022

Project Description: Saanich is working with a design consultant to complete the conceptual design of a full intersection upgrade at West Saanich Rd and Prospect Lake Rd / Sparton Rd. This will include improvements to traffic flow with safe access in all directions by pedestrians, cyclists and motorists to the Prospect Lake Elementary School, nearby businesses and the Interurban trail.

Project Goals:

- Improve traffic movements at the intersection
- Provide safe facilities that promote safe streets and more people walking and riding bikes
- Extend pedestrian pathway/walkway from Whitehead Park at Goward Rd to the Community Hall to close any gaps
- Upgrade Watermain Design from the intersection to the Prospect Lake school

February 8, 2022: DISTRICT OF SAANICH Construction Notice We are pleased to announce that the West Saanich Road and Prospect Lake/ Sparton Road Intersection and Sidewalk Upgrade Project has been awarded to Hazelwood Construction Services Ltd. During construction, work will take place during regular hours between Monday to Friday. As well, there may be work occurring during some weekends or during the night if the work is scheduled and permitted ahead of time.

Construction is scheduled to begin in the middle of February 2022 and will take the majority of this year. Experienced Traffic Management Personnel will be present at site during construction work. We request your patience and ask that you obey their instruction for safe movement. Appropriate signage will be in-place outside of immediate work zone to help direct vehicles, cyclists and pedestrians through and around the work area.

February 25 2022: Canadian Utility Construction Notice contracted by Fortis BC to install a new natural gas line. There will be excavation starting Feb 28 to install a new natural gas line through Prospect Lake Rd along the Interurban trail. It is estimated to be approximately 2 weeks.
