Principal's Report February 2015

Kindergarten Registration:

We are very pleased with our Kindergarten registration once again this year. Twenty nine students are currently registered. It is not unreasonable to assume that we will gain several more students before next September. These numbers are consistent with those of the last two years.

Tell Them For Me Survey:

This is a survey that is used by all schools in our District to anonymously gather data regarding the attitude and feelings of grade four and grade five students towards their school and school work. The information gathered enables staff to develop appropriate strategies to ensure students are connected to their school and engaged in their learning. Anytime the District considers using an outside agency or person to conduct a survey such as this in a school, the request is taken through a careful screening process. Once the District decided to use the TTFM Survey back in 2007, every year since we have looked at the results, shared the data with our school community in a variety of ways, and the District has asked schools if they support the continuing use of the survey in the following year. In future years, prior to the survey taking place, an information letter will be sent home to parents with the option to have their child excluded.
