This approach seeks to foster healthy behaviours and stronger relationships, by engaging parents, children and teachers in restorative ways. Key to this practice is the understanding that challenging and inappropriate behaviour is an opportunity for learning.

- gain greater understanding of child's needs,
- resolve conflicts and strengthen relationships, and
- apply techniques right away in parenting your child.

**Steve Newlove:**

Currently is Vice-Principal at Bayside Middle School in Saanich. While VP and psychology teacher at Parkland Secondary, he refined school discipline by applying Restitution and Restorative Practices into the school's conduct protocol, which decreased negative behaviours and improved school culture and tone.
